## August

*Schools open with appropriate exercises OR appropriate exercises to be scheduled on the school day prior.
** Data Recording \& Data Analysis -- Principals and teachers will have time for data recording and data analysis/progress assessment.
*** Data Recording, Data Analysis AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT -- Principals and teachers will have time for data recording, data analysis/progress assessment, and professional development. High School teachers will be given time as needed to prepare for upcoming semester.
${ }^{* * * *}$ ASSESSMENT DAYS- High schools will have the opportunity to administer traditional final exams or to use alternative assessment procedures.

If schools are closed seven days due to emergency conditions, it may be necessary to alter the school calendar. Additional days may be scheduled as required at the end of the school year. Depending on the use of emergency closing time, the calendar may be reduced if the time is not needed to meet the minimum required days/hours. One-half days may be modified. Teacher duty days will not exceed 191.
