Weight of student growth:	<ul> <li>Tested teachers: 40% (by SY 2018-2019)</li> <li>Multiple measures must be used.</li> <li>Beginning 2018-2019, 20% must be rated on test scores; the other 20% must be measured using "multiple research-based growth measures or alternative assessments that are rigorous and comparable across school."</li> <li>Nontested teachers: 40% (by SY 2018-2019)</li> <li>Multiple measures must be used.</li> <li>Measured using "multiple research-based growth measures or alternative assessments that are rigorous and comparable across schools."</li> </ul>
Role of student growth in overall score:	State does not require teachers to meet student growth goals to be rated overall effective.
