


Is **New Mexico** using evaluations of teacher effectiveness to inform policy and practice?

effectiveness?	Recommendation for State Action
No	Base tenure decisions on evidence of classroom effectiveness, rather than the number of years in the classroom.

No	Make aggregate school-level data about teacher performance publicly available to shine a light on how equitably teachers are distributed across and within school districts.
No	Develop compensation structures that recognize teachers for their effectiveness.

No	Require that districts consider classroom performance as a factor in determining which teachers are laid off during reductions in force.
No	Ensure that evidence of teacher effectiveness that determines whether teachers renew or advance their licenses is in the form of objective measures of student achievement.
No	Make evidence of teacher effectiveness the basis for granting licenses to out-of-state candidates, especially for those who come from states that make student growth a significant factor in evaluations.
No	Place student teachers with cooperating teachers with evidence that they are effective in terms if student learning.
No	Include data that connect student achievement gains to teacher preparation programs in the state's accountability system.
