## School Meal Prices

For elementary school students, lunch costs $\$ 2.25$. For middle and high school students, lunch costs $\$ 2.35$. Breakfast is available at most schools, and it costs $\$ 1.75$ for elementary school students and $\$ 1.85$ for middle and high school students. A la carte milk is 35 cents. Also, schools offer full and reduced* prices for breakfast, lunch, and à la carte items.
