I. Complete Application Form - Three (3) pages

II. Submit Required Attachments – Six (6) pages, depending on the length of recommendations.

1. **Profile of Teaching** (Type this heading on your document.)

Submit a written profile of your approach to teaching. Use the five NBPTS core propositions as points of discussion. Give **specific examples** from your classroom practice that illustrate each proposition. Write in first person. Keep in mind that this piece of writing should capture the life and heart of your classroom. Avoid writing a philosophical treatise on education.

The profile may not exceed **two** single-spaced, typed pages. Use Times New Roman 12 font with one-inch margins all around. Profiles that exceed two pages will not be considered.

The Five Core Propositions are as follows:

- 1. Teachers are committed to students and their learning.
- 2. Teachers know the subjects they teach and how to teach those subjects to students.
- 3. Teachers are responsible for managing and monitoring student learning.
- 4. Teachers think systematically about their practice and learn from experience.
- 5. Teachers are members of learning communities.
- 2. Context of School (Type this heading on your document.)

Provide a written snapshot of your school or classroom in terms of demographics, points of pride, challenges, etc. The context may not exceed **one** single-spaced page (same font and margin requirements as above).

- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation (At least one should be an administrator at your school or district.)
- 4. List of Education-Related Recognitions, Honors, & Awards Received (List Form Only One Page)

- 1. The program may require the participant's release for two professional leave days for planning and documentation each year of the candidate's participation in the cohort.
- 2. Participants will be expected to attend and be active contributors at required trainings, seminars, etc., which will be scheduled approximately once each month during the school year.
- 3. Participants will be expected to use district email and to check email at least once every 24 hours.
- 4. The National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) certification process is rigorous and very demanding; over 300 hours of preparation over nine months is required. Some candidates have reported over 700 hours of work.
- 5. The NBPTS certification process consists of e-portfolios and assessment center exercises. Participants are expected to meet all deadlines and complete all parts of the process. Participants are also expected to stay in regular contact with the district's NBCT Coordinator, Chris Reichelt, and meet all deadlines.
- 6. NBCT Certification is a two (2) year process and this cohort will provide support for both years. All candidates are expected to pass all the components necessary to meet the goal of becoming a National Board Certified Teacher.
- 7. Participants who do not participate in cohort meetings or complete their submission deadlines will be withdrawn from the cohort, and reimbursement of cohort fees will be collected from the participant.
- 8. Participants should receive support for this effort at the campus level.
- 9. Participants will keep campus administration apprised of progress, important deadlines and requirements, and any other appropriate information regarding the pursuit of certification.
