<sup>\*\*</sup>Certification: to be eligible for Additional Certification pay of \$2,000, two certifications are required, one of which must be in a high-need areas, as determined by the Office of Human Capital. Additional Certification pay is only available to employees not receiving additional pay for their Masters.
