

| Tenure                                       | No             | Base tenure decisions on evidence of classroom effectiveness, rather than the number of years in the classroom.  |
| Professional<br>Development                  | No             | Ensure that districts utilize teacher evaluation results in determining professional development needs and activities.   |
| Improvement<br>Plans                         | Yes            |  |
| Reporting of<br>Aggregate<br>Teacher Ratings | Yes            |  |
| Compensation                                 | No             | Develop compensation structures that recognize teachers for their effectiveness.   |
| Dismissal                                    | Yes            |  |
| Layoffs                                      | No             | Require that districts consider classroom performance as a factor in determining which teachers are laid off during reductions in force.   |
| Licensure<br>Advancement                     | Yes            |  |
| Licensure<br>Reciprocity                     | No             | Make evidence of teacher effectiveness the basis for granting licenses to out-of-state candidates, especially for those who come from states that make student growth a significant factor in evaluations. |
| Student Teaching<br>Placements               | No             | Place student teachers with cooperating teachers with evidence that they are effective in terms if student learning.   |
| Prep Program<br>Accountability               | No             | Include data that connect student achievement gains to teacher preparation programs in the state's accountability system.  |
