### **Substitute Application Requirements**

#### 1. Application for Employment

- 2.Two (2) confidential professional or volunteer, supervisory references (Please note that references from friends, neighbors or co-workers will not be accepted.)
- 3.Transcripts showing sixty (60) hours of college credit or a letter of recommendation from a Wake County principal or assistant principal (must have a high school or GED diploma) or providing a copy of the Substitute Effective Teacher Training (SETT) certificate.

## **The Application Process**

- 1. Complete the employment application. If you have a current-active application on file with Wake County Public School System you may have it cross-referenced for substitute teaching by contacting the Substitute Office (919-858-1758).
- 2.Complete applications are reviewed, confidential reference checks and criminal background checks are conducted on applicants.
- 3. If approved for employment as a substitute teacher, the applicant is invited by letter to a New Substitute Teacher Orientation and sent a N. C. health certificate, I-9, payroll direct deposit and tax forms.
- 4. Upon completion of orientation, submission of the N. C. health certificate and other forms, the new substitute teacher will be keyed into the AESOP. Then the new substitute teacher may register as a new user and receive their PIN and begin substitute teaching.
